Detailed Project Description and Justification:

This request is for the preliminary design of re-paving Bear Creek Drive. Bear Creek Drive was initially paved in 1982. The culverts need realigned, and the road needs a grinding and re-pave. Bear Creek Drive is a main arterial road in Kachemak City and provides primary access to over 100 properties in Kachemak City and the City of Homer. Also, Bear Creek Drive was a main detour during the re-construction of East End Road and had very heavy traffic for most of the summer. In addition, Bear Creek Drive has a school bus route that drives the road every school day of the year.
