Fairbanks - City of Fairbanks Street Reconstruction and Rehabilitation, Aurora Subdivision

One-Time Need

Brief Project Description:

Street reconstruction and rehabilitation of 9.1 lane miles of residential streets in the Aurora Subdivision.

Funding Plan:**Total Cost of Project: \$7,006,579***There is no other funding needed***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

The existing streets in the Aurora Subdivision were constructed in 1978. The mix of chip and seal and asphalt concrete pavement surfaces are unraveling and the structural section is failing to a condition that is beyond the City's ability to effectively patch and maintain. The project consists of reconstructing approximately 9.1 lane miles of residential street. The existing streets will be milled at full depth and incorporated into the existing base structure. Classified base material will be added or removed as necessary to match a design grade to be determined by the city and the contractor. The newly profiled base will be compacted prior to tack coating and paving with two inches of hot mix asphalt. All utility access point will need to be adjusted to match the final pavement grade. Aurora Subdivision includes Bridgewater Drive, Fern Street, Hilling Avenue, Jack Street, Capitol Avenue, Esquire Avenue, Carr Avenue, Central Avenue, Southern Avenue, Dogwood Street, Evergreen Street, Marika Road, Cedar Street, Bush Street, and a portion of Aurora Drive.

The estimate for project cost was based on ADOT&PF format at \$11.25/sq. ft., which includes the contractor's bid, 10% administration, and 15% construction engineering.

$(9.1 \text{ lane miles}) \times (5,280 \text{ ft./mile}) \times (12.96218 \text{ ft. avg. lane width}) = 622,807 \text{ sq. ft.}$

Total Project Cost = $(622,807 \text{ sq. ft.}) \times (\$11.25/\text{sq. ft.}) = \$7,006,579$

Project Timeline:

The project would commence upon receipt of funding. If funding is available by April 2010, the project would be completed during the 2010 construction season. If funding is received in June 2010 or later, the project would be completed during the 2011 construction season.

- construct a warm storage facility for City vehicles, Borough Haz-Mat and reserve EMS vehicles, and medical supplies; and


WHEREAS, the City staff has identified current capital priorities for the coming year;

WHEREAS, the public had the opportunity to speak to this Resolution at the September 21, 2009 City Council meeting.


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS
