The Copper Basin Senior Center building was built in the mid-1950's and served as the BLM Headquarters for over thirty years. BLM donated the building to the senior center and the building was moved to its current location. The existing roof is almost twenty years old and develops more leaks every year. The group has been told it would be cheaper to replace it than to try to repair it. The senior center also wants to enlarge the front deck and reconstruct the handicap access ramp.
