Funding Plan:**Total Cost of Project: \$10,000***There is no other funding needed***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

The Mountain View Boys and Girls Club has registered over 1,000 youth members. Their dedicated long-term staff, outstanding programming, meals, and transportation from area schools all make this clubhouse THE positive place for Mountain View youth. Programs include Power Hour (homework help/tutoring), drug & alcohol prevention, job readiness training, music recording studio, and Triple Play programs which promote healthy, physical lifestyles.

The Mountain View Boys and Girls Club facility is in need of basic repairs and equipment in order to maintain a safe and healthy environment for its youth members and the community at large. First, at least one heating/cooling unit in the facility is inoperable due to damaged components in a rooftop air handler. These components must be replaced to restore adequate heating/cooling functionality to the facility. Second, windows at the facility have repeatedly been broken with rocks, so the Mountain View Boys and Girls Club would like to install lexan windows which will prevent window breakage and decrease long-term repair expenditures. Third, the facility maintains three parking lots and numerous sidewalks, and the Mountain View Boys and Girls Club would like to obtain a walk-behind sweeper so they may more efficiently maintain the safety and aesthetics of the area.


