Detailed Project Description and Justification:

In FY09, \$22,000,000 was added to the general obligation bond bill for the reconstruction of Fairview Loop Road. However, this funding would only fund the rehabilitation of the existing 11 miles road. An additional \$4.3 million is needed to construct a pedestrian pathway along a 2.5 stretch of the road near Snowshoe Elementary School. The current roadway has no shoulders and is dangerous for pedestrians and school children.
