Project Description/Justification:

The court occupies space in twelve (Dept. Transportation and Public Facilities, Dept. Administration, Dept. Military and Veterans' Affairs) state-owned court and office buildings operated on the court's behalf by executive branch agencies. Currently the court estimates its deferred maintenance needs at a total of \$12.6 million dollars, and funding is requested for the highest priorities on that list, shown below.
