Funding Details:

A HUD EDI grant in the amount of \$475,000 has been awarded to the Kodiak Island Borough.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

There is no emergency shelter in the Womens Bay Community. Womens Bay is located 8 miles from town and 2 miles from the United States Coast Guard Support Center. Should there be a tsunami that destroys the roads, or a rock slide at Womens Mountain or Pillar Mountain, the community of 700 residents would be without support services. A logical location for an emergency shelter is adjacent and attached to the Womens Bay Fire Department. A 2,500 square foot addition with an emergency generator is proposed. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Economic Development Initiative funds in the amount of \$475,000 have been appropriated for this project.

Project Timeline:

This project is estimated to be a two year project from commencement of planning and design through completion of construction.
