Kenai Peninsula College (KPC) proposes the construction of a 100-bed facility at the Kenai River Campus in Soldotna to house students. With the anticipation of large new construction projects needing thousands of new workers, the demand for training at KPC will also increase. Along with increased student enrollment the need for short-term housing will multiply. Students attend KPC to receive education and skills training, and also pursue 2-year and 4-year academic degrees, enabling them to take advantage of jobs in the oil, gas, and mining industries. Without student housing, they have no avenue to pursue their education if they live outside commuting distance. In addition, KPC student housing will give rural students the option of attending college near their homes instead of leaving Alaska or going to a large city, which can be intimidating. The construction of student housing will place rural students on a level playing field with those from urban areas by providing access to a quality education and increased chances for success in college and in life. There promises to be a great return on this investment; students will benefit, the Kenai Peninsula Borough will benefit, and Alaska will benefit.
