Detailed Project Description and Justification:

Provide new steel piling, flotation, and non-skid surfacing for 430 LF vessel float, power and communication systems and pedestals, low level lighting, harbor crane, possibly some skiff fingers, excavate muck from beneath boat repair grid and replace with crushed rock, some armor rock, replace piling anchor guylines, provide water service and lighting. Replace deteriorated concrete piling foundation bases at upland access pier and re-secure timber bracing.

Project Timeline:

We request this project be executed during summer 2012. The facilities belong to ADOT/PF who may require some funding for reconnaissance and design in summer 2011. Demolition and construction funding FY 2012.
