Project will fund a study for improving marine transportation for Elfin Cove. Currently the community of Elfin Cove is only accessible by private seaplane and vessels. Despite being located along the Alaska Marine Highway, the community does not have the infrastructure to accommodate ferry service. This study will identify the options available and improvements necessary to bring AMHS service to Elfin Cove. Professional research will enable future policy calls and allow the community to engage DOT and other stakeholders in pursuing improved transportation options. Elfin Cove's economy is based on seasonal tourism and marine recreation. This funding is a good first step towards growing the community's economy and could have long-term benefits for the state and region. The project is strongly supported by the Elfin Cove community and industry stakeholders.
