Detailed Project Description and Justification:

Rural Deltana Volunteer Fire Department is responsible for rescue activities on the Richardson Highway from the Fairbanks North Star Borough to Trims Camp and on the Alaska Highway from Delta Junction to the Johnson River. The department also responds to mutual aide requests along the Richardson Highway into the North Star Borough, south of Trims Camp to near Paxson, and on the Denali Highway as well as east on the Alaska Highway to Dot Lake.

The department's old rescue vehicle is in constant need of repair and response to the edges of the district requires responders to stop and put fuel into the vehicle from 5 gallon cans before returning to the station.

The department wishes to purchase a first response engine/rescue vehicle combination. The vehicle will provide a platform to carry rescue equipment, haul an equipment trailer or rescue boat, and provide fire suppression capacity on the scene of a motor vehicle accident or similar event without requiring the response of an additional engine.
