Detailed Project Description and Justification:

Levelock village is located on on the Kvichak river. The village roads are currently sand and dirt; in the spring and fall the roads are nearly impassable and in the summer the dust is nearly unbearable. The incidence of asthma and bronchial infections is statistically higher due in the village than nearby communities due to the dust. To solve both the air quality and the road conditions, the village proposes to gravel the roads. BIA funding will pay for the gravel, but the village needs the heavy equipment to do the work and maintenance. There are four streets which have been surveyed, planned and passed archeological permits and are ready for construction. The completion of these streets will help make Levelock a healthier and more pleasant place to live.
