Purchase of replacement electrical utilities bucket truck. The bucket truck is an integral part of our community's power operations. It is the only piece of equipment capable of safely reaching the heights necessary for line and transformer repairs. The currently owned vehicle is approximately thirty years old and has reached the end of its useful and economically feasible lifespan. Due to wear and corrosion, it is in constant need of repair and the city is spending an increasing amount of time and money trying to keep it functioning, resulting in a steadily increasing backlog of critical utilities maintenance and increasing danger to the operators and ground personnel as a result of engine and electrical failures during operation. This project is an extremely high priority and a necessity for continued stability of power operations.
