

    - Char broiler 36" \$2,500

    - Stainless sinks and tables \$5,000
    - Vent system \$30,000

## **Future Projects – continued.**

- Kids Summer Lunch Program \$4,500
  - Repave parking lot - \$7,500
  - 2 handicap accessible vans = \$30,000
- Renovate two properties within the Fairbanks North Star Borough:
- \$25,000 Sheet rock
  - \$15,000 Furnace conversion to natural gas
  - \$5,500 Painting
  - \$6,500 carpet/vinyl flooring
  - \$7,200 install basement flooring
- **Labor for above project \$18,000**
