Purchase one 4-wheeler for community public safety patrols, prisoner transport.

### Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Tuntutuliak Traditional Council needs a reliable 4-wheeler for daily public safety activities. Village Public Safety and Village Police Officers will use the 4-wheeler for daily community patrols, home checks on domestic violence reports, and for transporting prisoners to and from the airport for transport to and from incarceration in Bethel.

Currently, public safety officers use their own personal transportation, simultaneously limiting their families' transportation options, and their availability for public safety use.

A model and safety light bar attachment have been identified for purchase, at a total cost of \$9,800.

The 4-wheeler and light bar will be purchased immediately upon receipt of funding.
