Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Rovenna Street / 74th Avenue storm drain system is no longer functionally adequate to handle the drainage flows. An improperly functioning drainage system contributes to deterioration of the road base. This project will replace and/or reconstruct the storm drains in this area, resurface the roadway, and improve the ditching. Project design has been funded with local road bonds. Construction funding is planned with a combination of state grant and local road bonds.

Project Timeline:

Design expenditures occurred in 2010 and 2011. Construction expense is anticipated in 2011, 2012 and 2013.

Resolution Number 2011-01

WHEREAS, the Taku/Campbell Community Council area has some of the worst condition residential streets in the Municipality of Anchorage;

WHEREAS, many area streets are riddled with frost heaves and pot holes due to improper drainage, which needs maintenance attention to prevent further deterioration and major road reconstruction;

WHEREAS, the lack of proper drainage on certain area streets flood houses every year, causing extensive damage to public and private property;

WHEREAS, residential streets in the Taku/Campbell Community Council area, while having received some patching and chip sealing, hasn't had any substantive reconstruction in the last six years;

WHEREAS, inadequate street lighting poses pedestrian, traffic and home safety dangers;

WHEREAS, area property values can decrease due to poor drainage, flooding and road conditions; and

WHEREAS, retaining, maintaining and improving infrastructure assets are keys to local economic opportunities and preventing major repair costs in the future.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Taku/Campbell Community Council supports state and municipal funding for flooding, glaciations and drainage relief, pavement rehabilitation, pedestrian safety improvements, traffic calming and safety improvements, and installing and upgrading street lights in the Taku/Campbell Community Council area.
