## **Department of Health and Social Services Information Technology Services Component Budget Summary**

**Component: Information Technology Services**

**Contribution to Department's Mission**

To provide reliable and stable technology systems, applications and platforms in support of the department's service delivery programs in as cost-effective and efficient a manner.

**Core Services**

- Provide business solutions to promote and protect the health and well-being of Alaskans through the Business Applications Section.
- Provide quality support services for all technology used in the delivery of the department's service delivery programs through the Customer Services and Network Services Sections.
- Provide a secure technology environment to protect the privacy of all customers receiving services from the department through the Strategic Planning Office and Network Services Sections.
- Provide quality services through the deliberate and effective use of technology.

**Key Component Challenges**

**Network Connectivity:**

- Enhanced rural Wide Area Network (WAN) connectivity including increased bandwidth and WAN Acceleration
- Technologies to provide acceptable network performance for business users.

**Staffing:**

- Recruitment and retention of professional staff continues to be a challenge. Providing career path to retain staff with the existing Human Resource (HR) classification system is problematic. Public sector compensation of IT professionals has and will likely continue to lag private sector compensation well into the future. We believe supporting innovative and creative ideas is our most likely path to success. Telework of eligible positions, flexibility in working schedule, and stressing quality of life are factors we intend to highlight in our continued recruiting efforts to attract and retain IT professionals.

**Data Protection:**

- Encryption solutions for email and data including during transport and at rest.

**Major Component Accomplishments in 2010**

**Division of Senior & Disability Services Corrective Action Plan:**

DHSS Business Applications completed a number of DSDS CAP-related deliverables during FY11: DSDS Offline Assessment tool implemented to aid the division in reducing its assessment backlog by using laptops in the field to conduct client assessments. DSDS Case Review implemented into SharePoint web application to fulfill CMS Compliance mandate. DSDS Compliant Tracking was implemented onto a SharePoint web application to fulfill CMS Compliance mandate. Medicaid Waiver application allows standardized way for all incoming waivers are processed more efficiently.

**GuardianEdge encryption software deployment:**

Led by the DHSS Security Office in coordination with DHSS Customer Services and Network Services, DHSS initiated the deployment of GuardianEdge encryption software. GuardianEdge encryption software DHSS is required under state and federal law to report breaches of personal information or electronic health information. A breach of security that requires notification can have significant consequences, including public disclosure of the breach to every person whose personal information was lost or stolen, loss of public confidence, and individual civil and criminal penalties. GuardianEdge encryption better protects this information and limits the liability to DHSS and its employees in case of a breach of security. High-risk laptops were targeted first, followed by all other laptops, then desktops. Training was provided to DHSS staff during the deployment process.

**Increased SharePoint functionality:**

Utilizing the centrally-managed SharePoint infrastructure, DHSS Business Applications increased the system's functionality with the addition of an Extranet Manager and a Customer Relations Management system. The Extranet Manager allows DHSS staff to securely invite stakeholders outside the organization for collaboration in SharePoint. A pilot project with Suicide Prevention Council was initiated to integrate the Extranet Manager with the existing Web Content Management system. The Customer Relations Management system allows DHSS to better manage complicated customer tracking needs. A pilot project for the CRM system was initiated with the DHSS Budget section.

**Data Center improvements:**

Throughout FY11, DHSS Network Services continued to improve data center infrastructure by expanding use of virtual server technology and exploiting commonalities across deliver technology solutions. Disaster recovery framework was expanded and was made possible by a new power backup system for the Juneau data center that will allow servers to operate for several hours on generator power without interruption.

**Microsoft Office2007 and Internet Explorer 8 upgrades:**

During FY11, the DHSS Customer Service unit deployed Microsoft Office 2007 and Internet Explorer 8 upgrades throughout the department's 3,200+ desktop and laptop computers. These complicated tasks required coordination with DHSS Network Services who pushed the software remotely for vast majority of the upgrades. Upgrades were completed in small groups and software training was provided to DHSS staff throughout the deployment. These upgrades allow department staff to utilize new business features and functionality.

Ongoing system modification and maintenance will require a service team in Business Applications Information Technology section. This request will establish the necessary business applications team to maintain the case management system by funding positions which had been held vacant to meet required vacancy savings.</p> <p>Without institutionalized support for the DS3 case management system, the division puts continued compliance with CMS directives at risk. Required information may not be retrievable for CMS reporting requirements and/or personnel will not have the management tools needed to meet CMS work performance deadlines. This will put continued approval of the long term care waiver programs operated by the division at risk of being disapproved at the federal level. Without the waiver program alternatives, all long-term care will be delivered through institutional settings such as nursing homes at four to five times the cost of waived services.</p>
