1	DHSS & DPS	Combating Domestic Violence in Alaska	\$1,510	\$450	Combined 3 projects - includes a multi-pronged approach of economic empowerment, violence prevention curricula, screening, a social norms campaign, and development of outcome information.
2	DOTPF	Arctic Mapping and Ports Initiative	\$3,690	\$2,310	Alaska's Arctic coast digital mapping and a detailed study of potential port sites. Mapping funding - \$2.19M federal request; \$810,000 State. Ports Study - \$1.328M federal request; \$1.5M state. Ports Study has \$172,000 federal on hand that the state can match at 50/50.
3	DPS	Continue Rural Drug & Alcohol Interdiction	\$1,000	\$6,595	Continue the Rural Drug and Alcohol Interdiction project, which focuses on preventing the manufacturing and trafficking of illegal drugs and alcohol and reducing their availability in rural Alaska through aggressive enforcement and community policing efforts.
4	DF&G	Bering Sea Crab Research and Management	\$1,000	\$0	Conduct biological research and stock surveys and to gather fishery information in the remote areas of the Bering Sea and Aleutian Islands for the management of area commercial king and Tanner crab stocks.
5	DF&G	Seal and Steller Sea Lion Biological Research	\$1,000	\$500	Addresses numerous federal responsibilities and requirements for marine mammals under both the Endangered Species Act and the Marine Mammal Protection Act, including: (1) population assessments; (2) recovery plans; (3) evaluating threats to populations to achieve delisting status; and, (4) assessing the marine mammal stocks.
