**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

The department recently completed a reconciliation of construction bond funds and determined that there is sufficient bond authority in a previous authorization available. This amendment to the Governor's FY12 budget request reduces the construction bond funds by \$3,000,000 for a new requested bond amount of \$1,000,000. This project will provide annual funding to meet airport needs for unanticipated building, airfield, landside projects and needs that arise during the year. Used to make improvements and correct minor deficiencies and solve problems created by unforeseen circumstances at the airport. Examples include projects to address deterioration, failures or damage to existing facilities.

**Project Description/Justification:**

Provide miscellaneous airfield and terminal improvements. Typical projects result from winter conditions, facility and equipment failures, and changed operating requirements by the airlines, security requirements, and Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) airport certification. Resolve minor deficiencies and solve problems created by unforeseen circumstances for both the airport and leaseholders.

The airport needs to react quickly to make needed repairs and improvements outside the detailed Projects Program. The projects are often needed to meet changed conditions created by airline operations or FAA requirements. This relatively small dollar project has been funded on a yearly

basis.
