Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

Improve Dillingham Airport by expanding the Runway Safety Area (RSA), replacing the Omni-directional Lighting System with Medium-intensity Approach Lights with Runway Alignment Indicator Lights (MALSR), and acquiring any necessary land. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.

Project Description/Justification:

The FAA mandates that Runway Safety Areas at all certified airports be improved by 2015. The Dillingham Airport is an important certificated airport in southcentral Alaska, with over 40,000 annual operations. This project will address longitudinal runway safety area at this airport.

Maintenance and Operating costs will increase by approximately \$107,800 per year, beginning in 2014.
