Project Description/Justification:

Revise the Alaska Traffic Manual Supplement (ATMS) and Alaska Sign Design Specification Manual (ASDS), the Alaska Environmental Manual (AEPM), the Alaska Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (ASSHC), and the Alaska Right-of-Way Manual (AROWM) for compliance with federal-aid requirements. The ATMS and ASDS modify the 2009 Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Alaska-specific application. The AEPM provides environmental policy and procedure guidance for the development of state funded and federal-aid projects. The AROWM provides property management, property acquisition, and relocation policy and procedures for the development of state funded and federal-aid projects. The ASSHC provide the general provisions and standard specifications for highway construction.
