Sandy Beach Park has been a staple of Petersburg's gathering spots for many years. With a covered shelter and fire pit, families have gathered for weddings, reunions, community events and especially for the perfect family picnic. As you can see from the pictures attached the shelter is beginning to rot and crumble making it a safety hazard for our citizens.

The shelter will be rebuilt to replicate its rustic feel. A new cement pad will need to be laid, while the structure will be rebuilt with local logs cut and trimmed for this project. The chimney and fireplace will remain the same and the timber will be tied into the old chimney's structure.

This project will also consist of rebuilding bridges along the short trails behind the structures. These bridges will be built using local trees in the fashion of typical forest trail bridges.


