The equipment request is for the Public Safety and Public Works departments.

The Village Police Officers and VPSO are in dire need of a reliable 4-wheeler to patrol the community on a daily basis. The vehicle would also be used to transport prisoners to the airport for incarceration in Bethel. Currently, the police use their own vehicles to patrol and transport. They also need the vehicle for home visits to check on domestic violence and other parole violation incidents.
