With volunteers' boats often in use for normal activities, there is a real need for a dedicated fully-equipped, heavy-duty boat to improve safety and efficiency of frequent water searches in the region.

Expenditures will begin immediately upon receipt of funds, and equipment put to good use saving lives as soon as possible.



BSAR is an all-volunteer group that uses their own personal equipment for search and rescue operations in the Kuskokwim region. This leads to extra wear and tear on equipment that already gets hard use through everyday life in Rural Alaska.

We have long needed a heavy-duty, fully equipped boat dedicated solely to supporting search and rescue operations. This will alleviate some of the wear and tear on our volunteer's marine equipment while at the same time allowing BSAR to improve the safety and efficiency of water searches.
