This project is to improve the safety at the Little Campbell Lake Beach. Currently, the beach access to this area is muddy, slippery, and has an abrupt edge that proposes a hazard to visitors of this area.

Break down of costs

- 200 feet of beach will be improved
- 20 depth
- Equipment, trucking and excavating
- Average of a foot and a half of 4,000 feet
- Install weed barrier and sand
- Compact the material
- Permits: core of engineer and storm wastewater permit
- Muni and federal permit
- There may be other permits

Neighbors of Little Campbell Lake in Kincaid Park would like to see the beach material stabilized.

The project will include:

- 1)Permit costs
- 2)Excavate 1.5 feet down. Area is 200 ft. x 20 feet
- 3)Remove beach area surface material

- 4)Put down weed barrier
- 5)Put down new sand
- 6)Compact the sand

Funds may also be used for way finding signs, kiosks, and trash cans.
