Greer Road on the lower Kenai Peninsula is a low-volume gravel surfaced road. This project would construct a bituminous surface treatment on the road in order to improve rideability, drainage, and to reduce maintenance costs.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The existing Greer Road is a low-volume gravel surfaced road. The existing road is difficult and costly to maintain due to the lack of quality surfacing material, numerous soft spots, areas of poor embankment material, and distance the from the Homer Maintenance Station. During the spring thaw, portions of the road become very difficult to drive through due to the surfacing material turning to "mud". This funding would allow for fixing the existing soft spots, improving the areas of poor embankment, minor gravel lifts, placing crushed aggregate base material, and placing a hard driving surface by constructing a bituminous surface treatment. The end result of this project will be an improved, hard surfaced roadway that will be safer, easy to drive on, and will result in reduced maintenance costs to the ADOTPF.
