Department of Natural Resources Information Resource Management Component Budget Summary

Component: Information Resource Management

Contribution to Department's Mission

To provide data processing services and electronic land records to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), and to assure public access to information and on-line government services.

Core Services

- Create and maintain the electronic state status plat maps that display location and distribution of state lands, property rights, and active DNR business cases and projects.
- Create, maintain, and upgrade DNR business transaction systems via a centralized database of land management activity; including case, customer, revenue and billing, location, Recordings, Uniform Commercial Code, and electronic document management.
- Create and maintain the centralized DNR Geographic Information Systems databases and electronic location services used for policy, planning, and land management decisions.
- Build and maintain the primary DNR public access web pages and Internet portals that support millions of public use searches into department databases.
- Provide computer support, networking, email access, data storage, security, server administration, disaster recovery, continuity of operations, help desk and other information technology services to DNR.
- Deliver internet-ready business systems to simplify the process of working with government on resource development projects.

Results at a Glance

End Result A: DNR business processes are efficiently automated and easy to use by customers, both internal and external. A positive environment for economic investment is created; applicants know what is expected.

Target #1: All DNR business transactions and permit applications can be conducted electronically.

Status #1: At the end of FY 2011, DNR had 20 online business services, same as FY 2010, out of an estimated total of 200. This is up from 19 in FY 2009 and 16 in FY 2008. DNR continues the effort to streamline permit processes through the capital project for Unified Permitting; every improvement made in this area results in better services for our customers and improved efficiency of our staff.

Target #2: 99.9% availability of DNR information systems at any time of day, or day of the year, excluding scheduled downtime for maintenance.

Status #2: 2010 shows 362 operational days / 99.1% availability for the year. High availability of DNR information systems improves public service and raises productivity of DNR staff.

Target #3: Raise productivity per GIS Analyst to 6,500 of cases completed per year reflecting benefits of automation.

Status #3: The mapping system continues to return value by raising the amount of work each GIS Analyst is able to achieve. The average amount of work completed by the GIS Analyst is 5,045 cases/updates per year. This has resulted in a reduction in the backlog.

Strategy A1: The DNR staff have fast, efficient, and standards-based personal computers to accomplish their jobs.

Target #1: Maintain a ratio of less than 1% of tech support for department customers.

Status #1: The ratio of IT network and desktop support staff to full time staff is about 1%. This low cost ratio is made possible by DNR and State IT Standards.

Strategy A2: Computerized systems are designed to support and enhance the business processes defined by statute, regulation, and management.

Target #1: Automate four business processes per year and put on-line for customers and staff.

Status #1: FY 2011: UCC (Uniform Commercial Code) online allows customers to file UCC documents electronically. A new version of this application is currently being tested by UCC staff and is

expected to be in production by the end of the calendar year. The new version will allow UCC staff to process UCC filings received by the online system via a new internal website and will eliminate the need for staff to print UCC filings, affix recording labels, and scan the documents. Since almost half of UCC filings are submitted through the online system, staff time to process the filings is expected to be significantly reduced.

End Result B: State Land Records and data are maintained, protected from natural disaster, and made publicly accessible.

Target #1: Reduce the total backlog of pending actions by 5% per year with the aim to have less than 1,000 pending actions.

Status #1: The backlog of pending work has dropped. Staff is able to keep it from rising since shifting work focus to database only updates. Reducing the backlog number is lessened due to new staff, limited resources and the amount of new work being submitted by the department. The backlog could be significantly impacted as the department addresses their own backlog work.

Target #2: DNR systems are maintained by operating funds. A tested disaster recovery plan has been prepared and is ready to execute if so ordered.

Status #2: DNR's disaster recovery plan is complete but cannot be implemented. While DNR's data is secure, the plan requires additional funding to ensure DNR's applications are retrievable in the event of an emergency.

Target #3: A statewide parcel database is created and maintained through the Recording Process, combining information on public and private lands.

Status #3: Parcel data from eight boroughs which include Anchorage, Juneau, Kenai, Ketchikan, Kodiak, Mat-Su, Northstar and Wrangell have been assembled and put into production. State records have been combined with borough and federal data and reports have been developed that provide historical and current land ownership and land use information. Work continues on adding native corporation information and relevant Recorder's Office documents.

Strategy B1: Automate update processes to DNR land records web site to assure current information is available for staff decision making.

Target #1: Utilize data entry at State Recorders Office to eliminate duplicate entry into Land Administration System (LAS) Mainframe System for mining claims, plats (surveys), and state deeds.

Status #1: DNR-IRM programmers have automated linkage of the following transactions:

Document Recorded (DR)

Plat Filed (PF)

Conveyance Recorded (CR)

These transactions have generated automated links to over 60,000 transactions in the Land Administration System, primarily in Title and Mining Case Files.

End Result C: Public can conduct business or query DNR databases without requiring staff intervention; lower the cost of doing business with DNR via automation.

Target #1: Accommodate a 10% annual increase per year for hits on our web sites, number of terabytes of data downloads, and the average of number of visits per day.

Status #1: FY 2011: The number of hits on DNR websites for increased by just over 25%. The number of visitors increased over 12%.

Strategy C1: Allow the public to complete on-line forms or make reservations and submit with payment at their convenience; save DNR staff time by reducing data entry requirements.

Target #1: 80% of all burn permits issued via the internet system.

Status #1: FY 2011: The number of permits filed online remained at 42%.

Target #2: 80% Reduction in Uniform Commercial Code (UCC) paper filings by implementing on-line UCC interactive process.

Status #2: FY 2011: 45% of the UCC filings were submitted through the internet.

Target #3: Execute 90% of State Parks Cabin Reservations over the self-help internet web site.

Status #3: FY 2011: The number of cabin reservations submitted using the online system remains at 95%.

Target #4: 90% of all firewood permits issued via the internet system.

Status #4: FY 2011: 95% of all firewood permits issued were internet based.

Applications for permits to utilize resources will be received with accurate information and processed in a more timely and efficient manner.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2011

Completed Clocks, Notifications, and land use permit components for Unified Permit Project.

Enhanced the Document Management Scan Center and scanned approximately 295,683 pages and 5,842 maps.

Automation of DNR Business Processes in 2011 resulted in:

- Over 95% of all cabin reservations were submitted using the online system
- 95% of the 1,300 firewood permits issued in FY11 were internet based
- Approximately 42% of all Burn Permits were filed online
- 45% of UCC filings were submitted through the internet

In the Governor's agency-wide effort to limit the growth of state government (for both positions and funding), some vacant positions were deleted, with the intent to utilize savings generated from the deleted positions to fund personal services funding shortfalls or other priority projects within the department.

The department deleted 20 vacant positions across multiple components. General fund savings from the deleted positions is reallocated between components to cover personal services funding shortfalls or other department priority initiatives.

Prior to these funding transfers, personal services funding shortfalls existed in many components at a level that was not manageable without either a general fund increment, or a reduction of positions (most of which are filled) and a loss of service. Shortfalls are primarily a result of when employees receive merit increases,

the cost is reflected in the personal services budget need, but the budget is not increased to cover the cost. The general expectation is that departments are responsible to cover merit increases through turnover and vacancies in a component, assuming that will generate savings to offset the merit increases. When components experience little turnover or have few vacant positions, there is no cost savings to cover the increases. The Governor's budget recognizes the need to cover these shortfalls by allowing for the transfer of savings between allocations.
