

# **State of Alaska FY2013 Governor's Operating Budget**

## **Department of Natural Resources Office of History and Archaeology Component Budget Summary**

Component: Office of History and Archaeology

## Contribution to Department's Mission

The Office of History and Archaeology provides an historic preservation program to encourage the preservation and protection of the historic, prehistoric and archaeological resources of Alaska.

## Core Services

- Identify, document, protect and restore historic sites and buildings
- Educate Alaskans and visitors about the state's heritage resources
- Provide policy and program advice to the Commissioner, Governor and Legislature concerning history and prehistory, historic sites and buildings, and geographic names.

## Results at a Glance

### End Result A: Historic properties are protected through review of federal and state projects.

Target #1: Review and comment on projects within 30 day review period.

Status #1: The ability to track the response times for all projects received for review was set up for FY 2012. Between the period of July 1, 2011 and September 30, 2011, OHA completed 685 reviews. The following table breaks down response times. 85% of project reviews are completed within 1-10 days. This is based on calendar days (not business days).

Response times:

1-10 days 580 projects (85%),

11-20 days 58 projects (8%),

21-30 days 36 projects (5%),

31+ days 7 projects (1%)

### Strategy A1: Provide guidance and training to agencies to improve the quality and completeness of the documentation submitted with a project for review, including cultural resource survey reports.

Target #1: Revise and update project review submittal checklist and survey submittal forms and post on Website.

Status #1: A Section 106 project review checklist for federal projects has been posted on the Office of History and Archaeology's (OHA) website. The project review checklist can also be used for state projects to be reviewed under AS41.35.070.

Survey report submittal forms are now posted on OHA's website.

Target #2: Provide training on the project review process and historic properties research and evaluation.

Provide monthly training on how to use the Alaska Heritage Resources Survey database. Provide annual historic preservation workshop for agencies.

Status #2: In FY 2011 seven AHRS training sessions were offered over a twelve month period with an average of six participants each. The AHRS training sessions cover how to retrieve and submit AHRS data and the basic Section 106 project review process. OHA's annual workshop for agencies and cultural resource specialists was held in April 2011.

### End Result B: Project review process streamlined.

Target #1: Reduce the number of projects requiring case by case review.

Status #1: In FY 2011 there were forty active programmatic agreements. Of those, twelve address on-going agency operations, maintenance and program management. Agencies with PAs with the State Historic Preservation Office include National Park Service, Bureau of Land Management, Army Ft Wainwright, Army National Guard, Forest Service, FEMA and FCC. Five of the twelve PAs addressing operations were completed in FY 2011.

**Strategy B1: Establish new agreement documents and maintain existing ones with agencies which modify and streamline the project review process for complex projects or routine and repetitive actions.**

Target #1: Enter into four new agreements. Maintain and monitor existing agreements.

Status #1: In FY 2011 there were ten new or amended programmatic agreements (PA) that streamlined the Section 106 process for federal agencies. Some programmatic agreements address large complex projects which span a number of years and the PA modifies the Section 106 process for that project. Other PAs address an agency's ongoing operations and maintenance and streamlines the way in which potential impacts to historic properties are taken into account for individual undertakings which are often similar in nature.

In FY 2011 there were also 15 memoranda of agreements (MOAs) for projects with adverse effects to historic properties.

**End Result C: Maintain an inventory of properties identified and evaluated to provide a knowledge base on which project planning and resource management decisions regarding preservation actions are made. Backlog eliminated.**

Target #1: New site data and associated records entered into database within 45 days of receipt. Backlog data entered into database and eliminated.

Status #1: AHRS users submit required information within 30 days of receiving a new AHRS site number. Required information includes accurate site location and site record data that is submitted in a format that allows for direct or easy entry into database.

In FY 2011 there were 1634 new AHRS number assigned. Data entry for complete AHRS records included 1065 new record entries and 1103 updated entries for existing site records. There is a current backlog of 6298 records to be entered. The annual backlog has been in the 9,000 to 8,000 range for a number of years. In FY 2011 there were about 36,200 reported sites. There is a related database of properties reviewed for determinations of eligibility which has about 6625 entries.

**Strategy C1: Develop Integrated Business System in Oracle that is compatible and integrated with the Department of Natural Resources land status data systems.**

Target #1: Continue development of IBS Oracle database. Complete import/export data programming. Improve access to digital site related records.

Status #1: In FY 2011 the ability to import/export shapefiles was developed. The ability to export in Google KML/KMZ format is included. Improvements made to Alaska Heritage Resources Survey PDFs to display site data from sub-modules and other access to reports and site data.

**Major Activities to Advance Strategies**

- Review and comment on development projects and other activities for impacts to cultural resources and compliance with laws and regulations.
- Consult with federal agencies as state liaison, representing the State's interest in protecting heritage resources.
- Provide policy and program advice to Governor and Legislature on history, archaeology and geographic names through the AK Historical Commission.
- Conduct cultural resource research and field surveys; prepare reports; develop historic preservation plans and historic structure reports.
- Administer Alaska's Historic Preservation Certified Local Government program; provide training and grants.
- Develop, update, distribute and implement Alaska's State Historic Preservation Plan.
- Make recommendations on name proposals to U.S. Board on Geographic Names
- Issue field archaeological permits for archaeological research and survey on state lands.
- Support public education efforts through the Alaska Historical Commission's publication program.
- Review and comment on government agency land use planning documents and industry contingency hazardous spill planning documents.
- Promote commemorative anniversaries of significant events, i.e. the Alaska State Parks 40th anniversary and 100th Iditarod Historic Trail anniversary.
- Provide technical assistance on appropriate treatment of historic properties.

**Key Component Challenges**

Protection of Alaska's heritage resources is best accomplished when information on the significance of the resources are available and the effects of a project on a resource is considered early in the planning process. The National Historic Preservation Act requires federal agencies to consult with the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) on all undertakings and assess potential effects on historic properties. Because of the increase in complexity, size and volume of state and federal projects in Alaska the Office cannot review and consult on all projects, which puts Alaska's heritage resources at risk. Since FY2000, there has been over a 50% increase in project reviews, from about 2500 project reviews in FY2000 to a high of over 4700 projects reviewed in FY2008, and about 3100 projects in FY2011. To reduce workload and streamline the federal Section 106 project review process, SHPO encourages development of programmatic agreements which allow for alternative processes which reduce the number of projects needing review by the SHPO. A major challenge is balancing the time working on project review versus spending staff time developing programmatic agreements to streamline the process.

Incorporating National Historic Preservation Act Section 106 project review requirements with the National Environmental Protection Act (NEPA) compliance requirements saves time and avoids delays in considering historic preservation issues. The Office is working with the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), through consultation, RSAs and a proposed liaison position, to help the agency incorporate cultural resources into their advanced planning and facilitate project implementation. DOT&PF and other agencies are encouraged to use the services of the Archaeology Survey Unit, authorized in the Alaska Historic Preservation Act, to conduct surveys early in the planning process so site information is available at the earliest stages of planning.

The Office of History and Archaeology continues to work with DNR's Land Records Section to modernize its record systems infrastructure through the use of a relational database, GIS and Internet technology. The information is used by DNR, other government agencies and contractors involved in the permitting process. The long-term goal is to develop an integrated record system available via internet with relevant historic preservation program data which will result in a streamlined permitting process. Consistent funding and staff time are a challenge. The database programming work is presently funded through RSAs, cooperative agreements with state and federal agencies and historic preservation grant funds. Although progress continues to be made, with the low level of funding for the project, it is taking a long time to develop the system.

OHA staff time devoted to the project is limited because of staff turnover and limited staffing. Staff working with the programmers to develop the system also have their regular workload maintaining the AHRS. Because of limited staff, the backlog of site records not entered into AHRS continues to grow. In mid-2011, there were about 36,500 reported sites with a backlog of about 8,800 sites not entered into the database other than a map location. When completed, the new relational database system will streamline data entry and staff will again be available to work full time to maintenance of the inventory.

## Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2013

No changes in results to be delivered.

## Major Component Accomplishments in 2011

- Reviewed approximately 2500 projects for impacts to historic properties.
- Provided public preservation education, development of websites, workshops and training.
- Provided research services for over 30 projects for state and federal agencies, including the Umiat Road, Ambler Road, State Navigability and RST projects.
- Provided historic preservation grants to local governments, state agencies, organizations and individuals with 24 active grants in FY11-12.
- Completed two historic preservation plans for selected state parks in addition to a new six year statewide historic preservation plan. Four historic preservation plans for state historical parks are under development.
- Provided recommendations, through the Alaska Historical Commission, on seven geographic names proposals to the U.S. Board on Geographic Names.
- Maintained the Alaska Heritage Resource Survey: updated user policy and agreements, assigned numbers and entered data for new sites, updated data on existing sites, and scanned related site documents. About 28,000 sites entered on database.
- Provided technical assistance and participated in K-12 educator training and curriculum development through Project Archaeology and Iditarod Trail to Every Classroom.
