## **Department of Public Safety Alaska Public Safety Information Network Component Budget Summary**

**Component: Alaska Public Safety Information Network**

**Contribution to Department's Mission**

Provide secure access to the Department of Public Safety's (DPS) Alaska Criminal Justice Information Systems (AKCJIS).

**Core Services**

- Manage computer systems for Alaska's Criminal History Repository and police "hot files."
- Provide support for the department's small computers, office applications, and specialized technology needs.
- Support the Sex Offender and Marijuana Registries.
- Support the statewide law enforcement community's secure access to the criminal history repository.
- Manage the Department of Public Safety's information systems (to include the local and wide area networks).
- Provide law enforcement summary case management.
- Develop statewide online reporting systems to support operational and management goals.
- Support interagency data sharing through data standardization, automation, and integration of agencies' systems.
- Plan for the timely growth of information systems to minimize impact on law enforcement operations.

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**Key Component Challenges**

As the Alaska Public Safety Information Network (APSIN) redesign project progresses, it uses a significant portion of department personnel time to contribute to and review development plans and work products, and coordinate with vendors and contract staff. Department of Public Safety (DPS) developers invest a significant portion of their time on the project, working closely with contractor technical staff. Coordinating the development activities of many parties working on various aspects of a large and complex future system in order to deliver products to users on a regular basis is demanding. In addition, as the new system rolls into production, additional operational resources will be required of this component to manage the redesigned APSIN system and support its users.

A key component of the APSIN redesign deployment will be the development of the Alaska Justice Advanced Exchange (AJAX) interfaces to allow data exchange with disparate systems. Currently there are 22 identified AJAX interfaces with an expectation that more will be desired as the new APSIN service matures.

During FY2012, there will be further deliveries toward the new APSIN production system. A challenge will be to support and synchronize old and new technologies during a protracted transition, and to train users in the new system. Deploying and integrating support infrastructure, including security, directory, and related systems, will be a significant undertaking, requiring both external resources and training for DPS staff. These efforts must be coordinated to meet state and federal standards while also supporting other operational systems used daily by DPS.

Working closely with partner agencies as they likewise upgrade information technology systems is a key factor in leveraging the investment in APSIN Redesign and achieving the benefits of automation and integration investments. Because many partner agencies, especially local law enforcement, have limited access to technical and financial resources, DPS is often required to provide leadership, resources, and funding to support multi-agency integration projects.

**Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2013**

The number of users with secure access to Alaska’s criminal justice information data and the use of APSIN in general is expected to increase with internet technologies and Virtual Private Networking (VPN). Significant investments in APSIN development will move more of the APSIN workload and costs off the mainframe, especially as it relates to reporting and maintenance. This move to the State of Alaska standard MS SQL Server database requires DPS to provide key operational support staff as well as a significantly more robust distributed computing environment.

**Major Component Accomplishments in 2011**

Accomplishments for the APSIN component in FY2011 include, but are not limited to:

- Continued DPS VPN Solution deployment to 100 percent of DPS desktops.
- Completed and deployed APSIN Redesign Build 5.
- Partial Traffic and Criminal Software (TraCS) and Alaska State Trooper (AST) Mobile Data Computer deployment to AST and local law enforcement agencies.
- Continued data center virtualization and high availability deployments.
- Continued Microsoft (MS) BizTalk 2009 Enterprise Service Bus (ESB) development, and deployment.
- Continued Microsoft SharePoint development and deployment.
- Timely progress on refresh cycle for all DPS desktops and laptops.
- DPS testing and support for mainframe upgrades (zOS, CICS, Natural, etc.)
- Provided APSIN access via TCP-IP to local law enforcement Computer Aided Dispatch systems.
- Deployed TraCS version 10.x and piloted Citation and Crash Reporting applications.
- Piloted TraCS Citation V3 with local law enforcement.
- Continued migration to updated MS products per DPS plan.
- Supported deployment of DPS local area network (LAN) to the new aircraft hangar and other DPS offices around the state.
- Development and preparation for deployment of an AST Records Management System (RMS).
- Continued development of a multi-agency reporting system for the ten-year Alaska Judicial Council Recidivism Study.
- Continued development of a new citation repository (EIMORE, the Electronic Minor Offense Repository).
- Continued development and updating of major web services.
- Supported upgrade of the FBI link for national criminal information system (NCIC) access for statewide law enforcement.
- Supported the compliance check planning capability in support of the Alcohol Beverage Control (ABC) Board enforcement.
- Supported the Alaska Law Enforcement Information Sharing System (ALEISS) system (migrated from the National Law Enforcement Telecommunications system).
- Continued the development of AUTO (Alaska Uniform Table of Offenses) to replace the UOCT (Uniform Offense Citation Table) system.
- Evaluated electronic bail conditions options.

Reconciliation adjustment for FY2012 Management Plan - AST restructuring

This Program Coordinator I (R18) position is being transferred from the Alaska State Troopers to the Division of Statewide Services, Alaska Public Safety Information Network (APSIN) to provide programmer support for the Alaska Records Management System (ARMS). Because this position will be providing programming support, it has also been reclassified to an Analyst Programmer III (R18). This position is the primary department resource for the deployment, configuration, maintenance, and support of the ARMS that will be used by Public Safety divisions and many local enforcement agencies across Alaska.

The Department of Public Safety received capital funding to develop the Alaska Records Management System (ARMS). \$775,000 in FY2012 (Ch5, FSSSLA 2011, Pg95, Ln29) and \$950,000 in FY2009 (Ch29, SLA2008, Pg74, Ln 13-14). ARMS is a complex application that is being customized and configured to meet the needs of Alaska law enforcement. This position will be responsible for implementing business processes using workflows, configuring code tables, creating forms and reports, and making a variety of other configuration changes. This position will also be responsible for installing and configuring the ARMS server and client application software, performing regular application software upgrades, creating automation scripts, and coordinating with information technology (IT) resources across multiple teams within Statewide Services.

This position will be funded via a reimbursable services agreement (RSA) for FY2012. The funding for the position will be transferred in the FY2013 Governor's budget request.
