Over the next several years this increment will support enhancement program processes and public interaction in the Norton Sound area. Funding will be utilized to facilitate a series of public meetings throughout Norton Sound area communities to inform and receive feedback on updating the Norton Sound Regional Comprehensive Salmon Plan (CSP). CSP's are the foundational document that guides development and implementation of salmon restoration and enhancement programs and require incorporation of significant input and direction from local stakeholders. Additionally, funds will be used for contracting with a third party facilitator tasked with organizing and directing the public meeting process and taking the lead on drafting and finalizing the updated CSP. Lastly,

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funds will be used for staff support of ongoing or developing salmon restoration and enhancement programs in the Norton Sound area, participation in the Regional Planning Team process, and participation in the overall process to update the CSP. Once the Norton Sound CSP update process is complete, any future funding would be directed toward implementation of similar processes in the Yukon Area and potentially the Kuskokwim Area as timing and funding levels allow.
