Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

Phase I will repave approximately 6.2 miles of Kalifornsky Beach (K-Beach) Road from the Sterling Highway to Bridge Access Road and improve the existing signals at the intersections of K-Beach Road with Bridge Access Road and Poppy Lane. Phase I will also include improvements to ATRs, guardrail, guardrail end treatments, removal of fugitive material from around guardrail, vegetation removal, dig-outs, improvements to pedestrian amenities at intersections that do not meet current ADA guidelines, drainage, signs, and striping. Phase II will include signalization of the intersections of K-Beach Road with Gaswell Road and Ciechanski Road, as well as a signal interconnect between the existing and proposed signals.
