Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

The EVOS Trustee Council is working with the Leisnoi Native Corp to transfer these parcels to the Kodiak Borough. Termination Point is a 1060 acre parcel owned by the Leisnoi Native corporation and located north of the City of Kodiak. Protection of this parcel would contribute to the Exxon Valdez Oil Spill Trustee Council's restoration goals for habitat protection of coastal, wetland and upland habitats provided by this parcel. Leisnoi Inc., is interested in selling a conservation easement and would retain certain rights.

Project Description/Justification:

Long Island is a 1334 acre island off the coast of Kodiak Island and approximately six miles from the City of Kodiak. This parcel is owned by the Leisnoi Native corporation and they are interested in selling a conservation easement and would retain certain rights. Leisnoi would retain additional rights on 141 acres on the northwestern point of the island to build structures and limit public access for a cultural camp. This parcel would assist the EVOSTC in reaching their restoration goals for habitat protection.
