

# **State of Alaska FY2017 Governor's Operating Budget**

## **Department of Education and Early Development Program Administration & Operations Component Budget Summary**

**Component: Program Administration & Operations**

**Contribution to Department's Mission**

Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education's mission is to promote access to and success in education and career training beyond high school.

**Core Services**

- Increase public awareness and use of ACPE's services as Alaska's higher education assistance agency
- Efficiently deliver state financial aid information and materials to Alaska students and parents
- Ensure Alaska's authorized institutions operate within academic, administrative and financial standards

**Major Component Accomplishments in 2015**

- Through the Alaska Student Aid Portal (ASAP), a web-based financial aid management system, the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education (ACPE) provided eligible Alaskans with information about their individual Alaska Performance Scholarship (APS) and/or Alaska Education Grant (AEG) accounts, and with the ability to provide online updates;
- ASAP, functioning as the financial aid management tool for participating postsecondary institutions for online certification of student enrollment and continuing eligibility, enabled paperless aid disbursement through schools to participating students, and was used to deliver approximately \$10.1 million to just over 3,000 APS recipients and \$5.5 million to almost 4,000 AEG recipients;
- Conducted APS outreach and public awareness through: 177 events, reaching a total of 8,470 individuals statewide; the APS.alaska.gov website; informational webinars for the public; and, self-serve resources and tools such as the APS Eligibility Progress and Initial Award/Continuing Eligibility Checklists;
- Produced the 2015 APS Outcomes Report on the first four high school graduate cohorts. Included in the report were: numbers and distribution of qualifying graduates; originating districts and geographic regions; utilization rates and related demographic characteristics. The report also provided rates at which APS students enrolled in developmental courses compared to other first-time freshmen and persistence rates for the initial cohorts of high school graduates (beginning with the class of 2011);
- Delivered Alaska Career Information System (AKCIS) support and training to teachers/counselors statewide. AKCIS has 85,202 student portfolios, including 14,991 new portfolios, and user activity at approximately 150,000 logins in 2015 relating to Personal Learning and Career Plans;
- Expanded the successful Alaska College and Career Advising Corps program while transitioning to a funding model independent of federal College Access Challenge Grant. The Corps currently includes 13 Guides serving more than 40 schools across Alaska. Three of the Guide positions are currently independent of Challenge Grant funding;
- Provided postsecondary planning information to 16,369 educators, students, and families at 435 events in 95 communities across all regions of the state, both in-person and via distance delivery. Of those individuals, 10,912 were reached in small-to-medium-setting personal events. An additional 5,712 students received services at Alaska College & Career Advising Corps schools.
- Through the creation of the Alaska Postsecondary Access & Completion Network – a cross-sector and statewide group of Alaska leaders - facilitated partnership, communication and advocacy to expand a culture valuing Alaskans' postsecondary attainment. The Network set a postsecondary attainment goal of 65% of working-age Alaskans with postsecondary credentials by 2025; commissioned research on Alaska's postsecondary access program environment; and hosted the first "Alaska Can!" conference attended by over 160 postsecondary access and success professionals;
- In partnership with the Department of Education and Early Development (DEED), Department of Labor and Workforce Development (DLWD) and the University of Alaska, and funded by a three-year, \$4 million grant from the Institute for Education Sciences, ACPE completed the design and development phases for ANSWERS (Alaska Navigator—Statewide Workforce and Education-Related Statistics), a project to link key data from Alaska's K-12 and postsecondary and workforce systems (P-20W) to provide policymakers, educators and the public with needed information about program outcomes across Alaska's public education and workforce systems;

- Offered Alaska students access to a very low-cost supplemental education loan, with a fixed interest rate of 6.7% and no origination fee;
- Further reduced borrower costs by offering borrower benefits on the 2014/2015 Alaska Supplemental Education Loan to lower interest costs to 5.95% after credits for repaying as Alaska residents and enrolling in automated payments;
- Originated \$3.8 million in loans to 520 borrowers;
- Serviced a \$401.2 million education loan portfolio;
- Supported online education loan accounts for over 35,000 borrowers;
- Enabled 1,237 Alaska students and their families to save ~\$10 million (an average savings of over \$8,000 per student) in tuition and fees through Alaska's membership in the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE) and participation in the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE);
- Through WUE, facilitated attendance of 599 nonresident, undergraduate students at the University of Alaska;
- Reduced operating costs by transitioning to electronic communications with ~7500 borrowers electing to go paperless, and by providing AEG and APS students with email communications rather than letters, saving in excess of \$12,000 in postage alone; and
- Serving as Alaska's State Authorization Reciprocity Agreement (SARA) portal agency, thereby; 1) providing Alaska's higher education institutions with a low-cost option to deliver their distance education programs in any other SARA participant state without the need to meet onerous state-by-state authorization requirements; and, 2) increasing Alaskans opportunity to more readily access distance education programs originating from out-of-state institutions located in other SARA participating states.

### **Key Component Challenges**

- Lack of low-cost methods of direct communication to Alaska high school students and families, to ensure receipt of Alaska Performance Scholarship and the Alaska Education Grant information;
- Ensuring Alaskans' current and informed perceptions about career/workforce readiness to result in increased high school graduation rates—particularly among low-income residents;
- Longstanding pattern of Alaska's students' low engagement levels with their postsecondary education programs which results in high attrition and low educational attainment rates; and,
- Delivery of Alaska Navigator: State Workforce and Education Related Statistics, or ANSWERS (P-20W Statewide Longitudinal Data System) information products which are high value, meaningful, and actionable for educators, administrators, policy makers and the general public with individual privacy ensured, through secure reporting protocols.

### **Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2017**

- Deliver products from Alaska Navigator: State Workforce and Education Related Statistics, or ANSWERS (P-20W Statewide Longitudinal Data System) Program Management Office. ANSWERS will deliver high value, meaningful, and actionable information to educators, administrators, policy makers and the general public;
- Streamline APS and AEG management system processes with technology-based enhanced communications to students at reduced costs;
- AEG program modifications result in more effective financial assistance and earlier eligibility notice to students, thereby facilitating higher credential completions rates among AEG award recipients;
- Loan program modifications result in increased on-time enrollment and completion rates;
- ACAC program successfully transitions to a model independent of federal College Access Challenge Grant, or ACPE, for the hire and compensation of ACAC Guides; and minimally reliant on ACPE to fund other program expenses; and,
- Downsizing outreach and early awareness staffing and services relative to end of federal College Access Challenge Grant.

The disposition of positions funded by this grant is as follows: seven non-permanent, full-time positions are being deleted and, in collaboration with participating Alaska school districts, nonfederal grant funding (Statutory Designated Program Receipts) is being sought for three full-time, non-permanent positions and one-half of a permanent position to assist these districts in delivering College and Career Guide services to their students. The remaining five permanent positions will be funded by interagency receipts (ASLC receipts) to continue delivering statewide outreach and early awareness services.
