

# **State of Alaska FY2017 Governor's Operating Budget**

## **Department of Health and Social Services Medical Assistance Administration Component Budget Summary**

**Component: Medical Assistance Administration**

**Contribution to Department's Mission**

Maintain the operations aspects of health care programs for Alaskans in need.

**Core Services**

- Claims payments
- Contract management
- Provider, facility and client services

**Major Component Accomplishments in 2015**

- During FY2015, the division realized a \$13.92:\$1.00 return on investment (ROI) for inpatient and outpatient utilization management (UM) services performed by Qualis Health, and a \$6.38:\$1.00 return on investment for case management (CM) services provided by Qualis Health. The overall utilization management/case management for FY2015 was \$10.81:\$1.00. Total net savings realized from services provided by Qualis Health was \$3,155,804 for FY2015. - During FY2015, the Operations Unit was responsible for adjudicating 637 second-level provider appeals of denied or reduced services and claims. The significant increase in new appeals was anticipated (74% over the previous year) as a result of processing issues related to implementation of Alaska Health Enterprise. During FY2015, 610 appeals were adjudicated (206 initial decisions were upheld and 404 were overturned); 27 remained pending/awaiting additional information. - In FY2015, the Health Information Technologies office implemented the ability for eight hospitals to submit syndromic surveillance reports via the Health Information Exchange, four organizations to submit immunization registry reports via the Health Information Exchange, and seven hospitals to submit electronic laboratory results reports via the Health Information Exchange. There are significant impacts to the department as a result of the Health Information Exchange being used to transmit data to the state on behalf of healthcare providers. These benefits include: reduction in administrative and overhead costs as a result of reduced number of interfaces between providers and Division of Public Health systems and registries, data standardization for all participating providers data utilizing Health Level Seven International (HL7), Logical Observation Identifiers Names and Codes (LOINC), and Systematized Nomenclature of Medicine (SNOMED) standards, availability of critical health data such as medications, conditions and allergies in the event of a disaster. The Division of Public Health specifically is receiving more de-identified data related to syndromic surveillance and electronic laboratory reporting than this division has ever previously received, this additional data allows Division of Public Health to be able to better conduct analysis and statistical trending across all of Alaska. - Health Care Services continued activities related to the federally-mandated project on International Classification of Diseases with extensive testing of system changes and, in June 2015, by deploying in the Medicaid Management Information System the International Classification of Diseases version 10 diagnostic and surgical procedure code sets, with Alaska Medicaid coverage rules. Disease classifications will increase from several thousand to more than 68,000 diagnosis codes and to 87,000 inpatient procedure codes. This is expected to improve health care quality, research, and public health reporting, as well as promote accurate reimbursement. The International Classification of Diseases, 10<sup>th</sup> edition mandate was successfully implemented by the federally mandated deadline of October 1, 2015. - In June 2015, the Medicaid Management Information System was modified to accept member eligibility for Department of Corrections' inmates whose hospitalization services are deemed eligible for Medicaid coverage. This is phase I of an ongoing effort to automate acceptance of member eligibility and process claims for this client population. Department Core Service 2.2, Division Core Measure 3

- In FY2015, Health Care Services leveraged participation in the multi-state National Medicaid Pooling Initiative (NMPI) to secure supplemental drug rebates for a variety of medications through the work of the Drug Utilization Review and Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committees. The joint work of the Committees and program ensured program resources were being spent in a manner that maximized the services received by the recipients. Department Core Services 2.1 and 2.2, Division Core Measures 2, 3 and 4
- Health Care Services Tribal Programs continues to assist with capital project oversight for facilities that play an important role in providing access to necessary services in rural communities. The opening of two long term care facilities at a \$40 million capital expense has created capacity for 36 nursing home beds to be reimbursed at 100 percent match versus 50/50 at non-tribal settings and realizes a savings of up to \$185.0 per bed annually. Also, a new \$12.6 million capital expense for a Pre-maternal home is opening in the Bethel area and will provide increased capacity from 24 to 32 beds for rural tribal services to be provided in the region. We continue to monitor construction of a 178 bed residential facility in Anchorage that will provide housing for those requiring necessary services at Alaska Native Medical Center, projected to save \$3.8 million in transitioning medical services from non-tribal to tribal settings this year, from open date of Oct. 2016 forward. #### **Health Information Technologies:**

- The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services issued a new rule for the Medicare and Medicaid Electronic Health Resource Incentive Program making updates to the program years 2015 - 2017 and for Stage 3 that starts in 2018. This rule will be implemented in FY2016 and will result in procedure and system changes to the Alaska State Level Registry and Attestation solution. The rule also makes significant modifications to how a provider can achieve meaningful use for the Public Health Measures which could both negatively and positively impact the quantity and quality of the data received by Division of Public Health. This new rule from Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services should make it easier for eligible professionals and eligible hospitals to achieve meaningful use and improve their ability to improve their care and coordination for their patients. Department Core Service 2.2
- Alaska Medicaid Electronic Health Record Incentive Program has experienced a slow increase in the number of attestations from eligible professionals transitioning from the first year of the program to subsequent years where there are significantly more requirements needed to achieve meaningful use. The impact to the department as a result of receiving less providers achieving meaningful use is there is a limitation on the quantity and quality of healthcare data the department is receiving from eligible professionals and eligible

hospitals related to their meaningful use data. There is also an impact to the department being able to achieve one of its measures related to providers achieving Stage Two meaningful use and providing access to their patients to view their own healthcare data. The fewer providers who achieve meaningful use, the less likely providers are providing access to their patients to view their healthcare data via patient portals. Divisions such as Public Health benefit from the meaningful use data in order to conduct healthcare analysis across all of Alaska. Department Core Service 2.2

Operations:

- Because of Alaska's vast size and rural nature, it is common for Medicaid recipients to travel out of their communities to receive medical care. As part of ongoing efforts to reduce transportation costs, the department issued a policy memorandum encouraging providers to coordinate multiple routine and non-emergent medical appointments for individuals into single trips, and to coordinate appointments of multiple family members into single trips. The memorandum also reiterated covered and non-covered transportation services, medical necessity documentation requirements, and conditions of coverage for medical escort. Department Core Service 1.1, 2.1, and 2.2; Division Core Services 3 and 4
- The division is challenged to implement and manage a new provider type for free-standing birth centers, in compliance with requirements of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. Newly adopted regulations will establish enrollment requirements, covered services, payment methodology, and payment rate. Department Core Services 1.1, 2.1, and 2.2; Division Core Services 2, 3, and 4.
- The division's Operations unit expends considerable time and effort to resolve a high volume of pended claims subject to additional review. Pended claims increased from 300 – 600 per month in FY2013 to 2,500 – 3,000 per month in FY2014 as a result of implementation of a new Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS), Alaska Medicaid Health Enterprise. During FY2015, the second year after implementation, staff manually processed approximately 700 pended claims per month, a significant decrease over the previous year. - For more than 50 provider types, the division's Operations Unit is challenged to oversee claims processing, resolve pended claims, provide responses to questions and inquiries, and adjudicate appeals in excess of 600 annually. Department Core Services 2.1 and 2.2; Division Core Services 2, 3, and 4
- Support with member eligibility, assistance with transportation issues, and identification of providers who are accepting new Medicaid patients continue to be the primary challenges for recipient services. Each recipient call is unique and requires research and resourcefulness to identify appropriate intervention. Other frequently occurring issues include access to dental care, management of enhanced dental benefits, and providers attempting to bill the Medicaid recipient for services. ## **Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2017**

Health Information Technologies:

- Substantial changes to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services Medicaid Electronic Health Record Incentive Program rules for Stage Two Meaningful Use will go into effect in FY2016. The final rule for Program Years 2015 – 2017 and Stage Three of Meaningful Use have been published by Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and this rule will significantly change processes and procedures for the Medicaid Electronic Health Record Incentive Program State Level Registry. In FY2017, no additional eligible professionals will be allowed to attest after June 30, 2016. This means the number of eligible professionals participating in the program will not increase in FY2017. It is anticipated that more outreach and marketing will need to be completed to ensure the existing eligible professionals understand the program regulations and are able to successfully attest to meaningful use and move through the stages of meaningful use. Operations:

- The division will implement and manage a new free-standing birth center provider type to comply with requirements of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and in accordance with newly adopted

regulations will establish enrollment requirements, covered services, payment methodology, and payment rate. Department Core Services 1.1, 2.1, and 2.2; Division Core Services 2, 3, and 4.

- The division will experience an increase in claims processing oversight, pends resolution, appeals, outreach, education, and other operations activities in proportion to the increase in individuals who have enrolled under Medicaid Expansion. Department Core Services 1.1, 2.1, and 2.2; Division Core Services 2 and 3

The other two positions will begin in FY2018 and FY2020. The initial costs of the three positions are \$351.0 (\$112.6 for the Medical Assistant Administrator III, and \$119.2 for each Medical Assistant IV position). Each position assumes hiring at step C with a start date of September 1, 2015. These costs include benefits.
