**Major Component Accomplishments in 2017**

During FY2017, the Data Processing component:

- Worked with the department’s Unemployment Insurance (UI) and Labor Market Information components to develop a predictive data analytics model to reduce UI benefit overpayments.
- Finalized the move of Job Centers off the state network to better serve the public and maintain the security of the state network.

**Key Component Challenges**

A key challenge for the Data Processing component will be replacement of two of the department’s workforce development systems before they reach end of life with one integrated system to comply with federal requirements. There is federal funding available to cover the costs of this project.

**Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2019**

No significant changes in results to be delivered are anticipated.
